Wilson Batting Helmets
Custom Modifications Policy

From time to time, leagues, organizations, and players are interested in applying their own after-market paints and/or decals (“Custom Modifications”) to their Wilson, Louisville Slugger, DeMarini, or EvoShield batting helmets (collectively, “Wilson”).

Wilson batting helmets are inspected and certified by NOCSAE. Certain Custom Modifications to Wilson batting helmets may affect the performance specifications as originally intended and, thereby, may cause the batting helmet to become noncompliant with NOCSAE’s standards. However, the application of conventional, self-adhesive decals to the outside or exterior part of the helmet will not negatively affect the integrity or protection of the helmet.

Such decals should not be used to:

- (1) Cover more than 20% of the batting helmet’s surface area; or,
- (2) Cover or obstruct the NOCSAE logo, or any Wilson logo(s) or warning labels.

Note – Covering or removing these logos or labels will void the NOCSAE approval of the helmet.

Wilson does not endorse, approve, or recommend the use of extra adhesives, heat, epoxies, other chemicals, or any other attachment means or methods that may alter the properties of the batting helmet’s material. Certain means or methods may alter the original properties of the helmet, thereby negatively affecting the integrity or effectiveness of the helmet.

DO NOT USE any solvents or chemical cleaners to remove decals or to clean the batting helmet. To clean the batting helmet, use only warm water and soap or rubbing alcohol.

Any and all applicable warranties with respect to Wilson batting helmets are voided by the use of decals, coatings, and/or paints inconsistent with the aforementioned terms.
